Supply List

- Sewing machine in good working order with manual and all attachments
- Walking foot already attached to your machine, or built in dual-feed
- Free motion foot to fit your machine, also known as a darning foot
- 12 practice quilt samples consisting of two 10" fabric squares with a layer of batting in between. Bring them pre-basted preferably with basting spray
- 100% cotton thread, size 50 weight in a color to match your practice samples
- Brand new machine needles size 80 – universal, sharp, or quilting needle
- Water soluble marking pen and a straight edge, painter's or masking tape
- Pen or pencil and sketchbook for notes
- Optional – Supreme Slider and Machinger's Quilting Gloves
- Basic Sewing Supplies
- Extra needles, bobbins, thread snips
- Pen and paper for note-taking
